Canned Fruit/Vegetable Item **Canned Food Guidelines:**

- Jars used for canning must be standard colorless glass jars, sealed with two-piece lacquer lids. Jars with zinc lids will not be accepted. Jellies must be in standard jelly jars. No jelly sealed with paraffin wax will be accepted.
- Each entry must have a plain white label stating: product – specify name of canned food; date - month and year processed (all products must be less than 1 year since process date); method - specify either boiling water bath or pressure canned with pounds of pressure noted; and time processed - note the time in minutes. Please do not include your name on canning labels.
- All canned products and jellies must have tags attached with string.
- Food Preservation will not be opened.
- Recipes need not accompany classes.
- Canned goods will be displayed in regulation jars with rings left on.
- Any sign of spoilage, unsealed jars or alteration from recommended procedures will be basis for disqualification.
